

Non-Employee: U.S. Person Verification Accepted Documents

During the U.S. Person Verification appointment, you must bring **one document/document set** listed below, **in addition to an Employment Verification Letter**. For more information on the Employment Verification, check the USPV – Employment Verification Letter info card.

All documents must be current and unexpired.

IMPORTANT: Unless otherwise specified in the list below, only original documents will be accepted for your proofing appointment.

Section A: List of Acceptable Documents

If you do not have any of the documents listed below, refer to section B for additional documents that you may bring to your proofing.

- Unexpired United States Passport
- Unexpired United States Passport Card
- Unexpired Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card with photograph (Form I-551)
- Unexpired Foreign passport with Alien Registration stamp (I-551 stamp)
- Certificate of United States Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561), **AND** accompanied by a photo ID from a state or federal agency
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N-550 or N-570), **AND** accompanied by a photo ID from a state or federal agency
- Certification of birth abroad issued by United States Department of State (Form FS-545 or DS1350) or Consular Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. Citizen (Form FS-240), **AND** accompanied by a photo ID from a state or federal agency
- Original or Certified Copy of Public Birth Certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority, or outlying possession of the United States, bearing an official seal, **AND** accompanied by a photo ID from a state or federal agency
